3. One World: Seek Justice through Faith and Policy
  - 3.1 Several students from CBC (Derek, Chelsea and Katrina) are going to attend this conference in Ottawa
  - 3.2 This event is sponsored by MCC Canada, who is covering the cost of their flights
  - 3.3 Discussion as to whether STUCO will support these students financially
    - 3.3.1 STUCO will support each of these students with \$100 to help cover the cost of hotels, meals and registration fees
