

TRANSFER GUIDE: Canadian Mennonite University

Terms of Transfer

1. CMU will grant transfer credit equivalent to the hours the student has earned at CBC to a maximum of 60 credit hours for any student meeting the following criteria:
 - a. The student has completed a minimum of 30 credit hours of course work at CBC
 - b. The student has achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher at CBC and a minimum grade of 'C' in each course
 - c. The student is choosing a four-year degree program at CMU. For students choosing a three-year program at CMU the maximum credit-for-credit transfer is 45 credit hours.
2. CMU will assess transfer credit for any student who does not meet the above criteria but meets CMU's regular admissions requirements according to existing policies regarding transfer of credit. Note: A student's transfer credit may or may not all fit into the program the student chooses at CMU, depending on the CMU program chosen. Please contact CMU Admissions for further information.
