

C1 Leader Job Description



Columbia One (C1) Leaders are individuals who display a commitment to faith, community and culture and have a desire to support holistic growth in the lives of others. C1 Leaders are key contributors in helping make C1 a meaningful experience of transformation in students' lives.

Qualifications/expectations

- Exhibit maturity and responsibility in faith and life
- Show initiative in relationships and responsibilities
- Ability to work in a team environment
- Uphold all CBC community standards
- Completed at least one year of academic studies at CBC (3rd/4th year student preferred)
- Current CBC student with a 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Willingness to get a Class 4 driver's license (if necessary)

Responsibilities (average of 8-10 hrs/week)

Required

- Participate in the Student Development leadership training program
- Attend the New Student Retreat (early September)
- On-campus connecting: be a presence with C1 students during informal times on campus (e.g. dining hall, student lounge, etc...), developing friendships and helping foster a strong sense of community within the program
- Mentoring: connect regularly with C1 students one-on-one to provide support and encouragement
- Lead a C1 cohort: plan and lead regular connections with a small group within C1 (e.g. Culture Stream Cohort)
- Help plan and run C1 special events
- Help lead C1 experiential learning trips
- Other duties as determined appropriate by the C1 Director

Additional opportunities (to be assessed based on experience and need)

- Serve as a leader for C1 UMD placements
- Academic support: lead a weekly study session
- TA work: help with C1 courses where applicable
- Committee work: join a STUCCO committee to give voice for C1 and explore an area of interest/calling (e.g. Arts, Missional Life, etc...)
- Drive a 15-passenger van for some of the group activities (if necessary)
